Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to improve your spelling skills while learning about autumn.

Materials and Prep

- Pen or pencil
- Blank paper or notebook
- Access to a computer or device with internet
- Optional: Autumn-themed books or magazines for inspiration

Activities

- 1. Autumn Word Search: Create a word search puzzle using autumn-related words. Include words like "leaves," "pumpkin," "harvest," "sweater," and "apple." Solve the word search to find all the words.
- 2. Seasonal Acrostic Poem: Write an acrostic poem using the word "AUTUMN." Each line of the poem should start with one letter from the word "AUTUMN" and describe something related to autumn. For example:
 - A Apples falling from trees
 - U Unraveling scarves and cozy sweaters
 - T The crisp air and colorful leaves
 - U Upcoming Thanksgiving feast
 - M Harvesting pumpkins and corn
 - N Nature's beauty in full display
- 3. Autumn Spelling Bee: Challenge yourself with a spelling bee using autumn-related words. Start with easier words and gradually increase the difficulty. Use the words from the word search and acrostic poem as a starting point.

Fifth Grade Talking Points

- "Autumn is one of the four seasons we experience throughout the year."
- "During autumn, the weather starts to cool down, and the leaves on trees change color and fall."
- "People often associate autumn with harvest festivals, pumpkins, apples, and Thanksgiving."
- "Acrostic poems are a fun way to express ideas or feelings using the letters of a word as the starting point for each line."

• "Spelling bees are competitions where participants are asked to spell words correctly."
