## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to create your own drawing videos using simple materials.

## **Materials and Prep**

- Paper
- Pencils or crayons
- Coloring markers or paints (optional)
- Device with a camera (e.g., smartphone or tablet)
- Basic video editing software (optional)

No prior knowledge is required for this lesson.

## Activities

• Create a storyboard:

Draw a sequence of pictures to plan out your video. Think about the beginning, middle, and end of your story. What will happen in each scene?

• Draw your characters and scenes:

Using your storyboard as a guide, draw your characters and scenes on separate pieces of paper. Make sure to add color and details to make your drawings come to life!

• Record your video:

Using a device with a camera, record each scene of your story. Make sure to hold the camera steady and capture all the details of your drawings.

• Edit your video (optional):

If you have access to basic video editing software, you can import your recorded scenes and arrange them in the correct order. You can also add background music or sound effects to make your video even more exciting!

• Show and share:

Once your video is ready, gather your family or friends and have a special screening. Share your creation and explain the story behind your drawings.

## **Talking Points**

- "Today, we are going to learn how to create our own drawing videos!"
- "First, we need to plan out our video by creating a storyboard. It's like making a comic strip to help us organize our ideas."
- "Next, we will draw our characters and scenes. Remember to add color and details to make them look interesting."
- "After we finish drawing, we will use a camera to record each scene of our story. Make sure to

hold the camera steady and capture all the details of your drawings."

- "If you have access to video editing software, we can also learn how to edit our video. We can arrange the scenes in the correct order and add music or sound effects."
- "Finally, we will have a special screening to show our video to our family and friends. We can explain the story behind our drawings and share our creativity!"
