

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to explore the connections between rap music and various academic subjects, including English, History, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

Materials and Prep

- Pen and paper
- Computer or smartphone with internet access
- Access to a music streaming platform or a collection of rap songs

Activities
