

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the 4-year-old student will be able to write a simple poem using basic language and creativity.

Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Colorful markers or crayons

No prior knowledge or preparation is required for this lesson.

Activities

- Activity 1: Brainstorming Words

Encourage the student to think of words that they like or find interesting. Write down these words on a piece of paper.

- Activity 2: Creating a Poem

Using the words from the previous activity, help the student arrange them into short phrases or sentences to form a poem. Encourage them to be creative and use their imagination.

- Activity 3: Illustrating the Poem

After writing the poem, ask the student to draw a picture that represents their poem. They can use the colorful markers or crayons to make their illustration vibrant and engaging.

Talking Points

- Words are like colors that we can use to create beautiful poems.
- Think of words that make you happy or excited.
- Let's write down these words on a piece of paper.
- Now, let's arrange these words in a special way to create a poem.
- Use your imagination to make the poem interesting and fun.
- Once you have written your poem, let's draw a picture that goes with it.
- Choose colorful markers or crayons to make your illustration bright.
- Remember, there are no right or wrong answers in art and poetry. Just have fun!
