## **Objective**

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to greet someone in French using basic phrases like bonjour (hello), merci (thank you), au revoir (goodbye), bonne nuit (good night), and introduce yourself and others using phrases like je suis (I am) and tu es (you are).

## **Materials and Prep**

- Pen/pencil and paper
- Enthusiasm to learn!

## **Activities**

- **Greetings Matching Game:** Write down the French phrases (bonjour, merci, au revoir, bonne nuit) on separate pieces of paper and have the student match them to their English translations.
- **Role Play:** Practice greeting each other using the phrases learned. For example, one person can say "Bonjour, je suis [name]" and the other can respond with "Bonjour, tu es [name]."
- **Drawing Activity:** Have the student draw a picture of a scene where they can use the phrases learned, like saying good night to someone or thanking them.

## **Talking Points**

- Useful Phrases:
  - **Bonjour (Hello):** Say "bonjour" when you meet someone.
  - Merci (Thank you): Use "merci" to say thank you.
  - Au revoir (Goodbye): Say "au revoir" when you are leaving.
  - Bonne nuit (Good night): Use "bonne nuit" before going to bed.
  - Je suis (I am): Use "je suis" to introduce yourself.
  - **Tu es (You are):** Use "tu es" to talk about someone else.
