

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to use your erector building set to create different structures while practicing math and reading skills.

## Materials and Prep

- Erector building set
- Math flashcards
- Reading book
- Space for building

No special preparations needed, just bring your enthusiasm and creativity!

## Activities

- **Math Building:** Use your erector set to build a structure with a specific number of pieces. For example, build a tower using 10 pieces.
- **Reading Challenge:** Before starting a new building project, read a page from your favorite book. For each new page you read, add a new element to your erector creation.
- **Shape Exploration:** Create different shapes using your erector set and identify them using flashcards. For example, build a square and match it with the word "square" on the flashcard.

## Talking Points

- *"Let's count together how many pieces we need to build our tower. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10! We have 10 pieces, just like we planned!"*
- *"Reading is fun! Every time we read a new page, we get to add something new to our creation. What do you think we should add next?"*
- *"Can you show me a triangle you built with your erector set? Great job! Now let's find the word 'triangle' on the flashcards."*
