## **Objective**

By the end of this lesson, the student will have explored various subjects through the theme of Finding Nemo, enhancing their creativity, critical thinking, and physical skills.

## **Materials and Prep**

Materials: Paper, coloring supplies, scissors, glue, measuring tape, music player, space for physical activities, water and a fish-themed snack.

Prep: Familiarize yourself with the movie Finding Nemo if you haven't already.

## **Activities**

- 1. Art: Create your own underwater scene with Nemo and his friends using coloring supplies and paper.
- 2. English: Write a short story about an adventure with Nemo and his friends.
- 3. Math: Measure and cut out fish shapes of different sizes, then order them from smallest to largest.
- 4. Music: Dance and move like different sea creatures while listening to the Finding Nemo soundtrack.
- 5. Physical Education: Pretend to swim like Nemo and his friends, moving around the room in different ways.
- 6. Science: Learn about different sea animals that live in the ocean, like clownfish and sharks.
- 7. Social Studies: Talk about the importance of friendship and teamwork, just like Nemo and his friends.

## **Talking Points**

- "Nemo is a brave little fish who goes on an exciting adventure in the ocean."
- "Let's use our imagination to create a colorful underwater world like in Finding Nemo."
- "Can you count how many fish are in the picture? Let's practice our numbers!"
- "How do you think a shark moves in the water? Let's try to move like one!"
- "Friendship is important. Nemo and his friends help each other. Who is your best friend?"
