Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will learn about Chinese New Year and its traditions.

Materials and Prep

Materials needed: paper, markers or crayons, scissors, red envelopes (can be made from paper), and a computer or tablet for research.

Before the lesson, make sure to have some knowledge about Chinese New Year customs and traditions.

Activities

- 1. Create your own Chinese New Year decorations using paper and markers.
- 2. Make your own red envelopes and write good luck messages on them.
- 3. Watch videos or look at pictures online to see how Chinese New Year is celebrated in China.

Talking Points

- Chinese New Year is a special holiday celebrated by people in China and around the world.
 - "Chinese New Year is like a big party where families and friends come together to celebrate."
- People clean their houses and decorate them with red decorations to welcome the new year.
 - "Cleaning our house and putting up decorations helps us start the new year fresh and happy."
- During Chinese New Year, people give red envelopes with money inside for good luck.
 - "Receiving red envelopes is exciting because it brings good luck and blessings for the new year."
- People also enjoy special foods like dumplings and fish during Chinese New Year.
 - "Eating dumplings and fish during Chinese New Year brings us wealth and prosperity."
