Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to identify the eight parts of speech using the lyrics of a song.

Materials and Prep

- Pen and paper
- Access to the lyrics of a song
- Basic understanding of the eight parts of speech

Activities

- Sing Along: Listen to the song and sing along. Pay attention to the words being used.
- **Identify Parts of Speech:** Write down the lyrics of the song. Identify and label each word with its respective part of speech.
- **Create Sentences:** Use the identified words to create new sentences, highlighting the different parts of speech.

Talking Points

- Noun: "A noun is a person, place, or thing. Can you find a noun in the lyrics?"
- Verb: "A verb shows action or a state of being. Which word in the song is a verb?"
- **Adjective:** "An adjective describes or modifies a noun. Can you identify an adjective in the lyrics?"
- Adverb: "An adverb modifies a verb, adjective, or another adverb. Look for an adverb in the song."
- Pronoun: "A pronoun takes the place of a noun. Find a pronoun in the lyrics."
- **Preposition:** "A preposition shows the relationship between a noun and another word. Identify a preposition in the song."
- **Conjunction:** "A conjunction connects words, phrases, or clauses. Can you spot a conjunction in the lyrics?"
- **Interjection:** "An interjection expresses emotion or exclamation. Listen for an interjection in the song."
