Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will have a better understanding of the diverse cultures, geography, and wildlife of Africa.

Materials and Prep

- Map of Africa
- Notebook and pen
- Access to the internet for research

No prior knowledge required, just bring your curiosity and enthusiasm!

Activities

- Explore African Cultures: Research and create a presentation on a specific African tribe or culture. Include traditional clothing, food, and customs.
- **Wildlife Safari:** Create a list of African animals and draw or print pictures of them. Learn interesting facts about each animal.
- **Geography Challenge:** Use the map of Africa to locate and mark major countries, rivers, and deserts. Quiz yourself or a family member!

Talking Points

- **Cultures:** "Did you know that Africa is home to over 3,000 different ethnic groups, each with its own unique traditions and languages?"
- **Wildlife:** "Africa is famous for its 'Big Five' animals lions, elephants, buffalos, leopards, and rhinos. Can you name them all?"
- **Geography:** "Africa is the second largest continent in the world. It has diverse landscapes including deserts, savannas, and rainforests. Can you find the Sahara Desert on the map?"
