## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will have explored different subjects through activities inspired by the movie Wall-E.

## **Materials and Prep**

Materials: Paper, coloring supplies, music player, open space for physical activities.

Prep: Watch the movie Wall-E beforehand to get inspiration for the activities.

## Activities

- 1. Art: Create your own robot drawing inspired by Wall-E.
- 2. English: Write a short story about a robot's adventures.
- 3. Music: Dance to the movie soundtrack or create your own robot dance routine.
- 4. Science: Learn about recycling and create a mini recycling project at home.
- 5. Math: Count how many different types of robots you see in the movie.
- 6. Physical Education: Create an obstacle course inspired by the movie's setting.
- 7. Social Studies: Research about space exploration and discuss how it relates to the movie.

## **Talking Points**

- Art: "Let's draw a robot just like Wall-E! What colors should we use?"
- English: "Can you tell me a story about a robot who goes on an exciting journey?"
- History: "Did you know that robots have been a part of our lives for a long time? Let's learn more about their history."
- Math: "Let's count how many times Wall-E says his name in the movie. Ready, go!"
- Music: "Listen to this music from Wall-E. How does it make you feel? Let's dance to the beat!"
- Physical Education: "Time to move like a robot! Stretch your arms and legs just like Wall-E."
- Science: "Did you know that recycling helps our planet, just like Wall-E helps clean up Earth? Let's recycle together!"
- Social Studies: "Space exploration is fascinating! Let's imagine what it would be like to travel to space like Wall-E."
