

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will learn about different subjects through activities inspired by the movie Encanto.

## Materials and Prep

- Coloring materials
- Blank paper
- Music player
- Open space for physical activities

No prior knowledge required, just bring your creativity and enthusiasm!

## Activities

- Create your own magical family house inspired by the artwork in Encanto.

Draw a colorful house with special powers just like the Madrigal family's house.

- Listen to the songs from Encanto and try to dance along to the music.

Move your body to the rhythm and feel the magic of music!

- Learn about the history of Colombia, the setting of Encanto, and draw a map of the country.

Discover where the story takes place and draw the shape of Colombia on a piece of paper.

- Practice counting and basic math by counting how many magical objects you can find in your house.

Count how many toys, books, or other items you have and write the numbers down.

- Imitate the animals featured in the movie for a fun physical education activity.

Pretend to be a jaguar, a peacock, or any other animal and move like them.

- Perform a simple science experiment by mixing colors to create a magical potion.

Combine different colors of water or paint and observe how they change when mixed.

- Learn about different cultures and traditions by exploring the themes of family and community in Encanto.

Discuss the importance of family and how different cultures celebrate togetherness.

- Art: "Art is a way to express your imagination and creativity through colors and shapes."
- English: "Reading books and telling stories can take you on magical adventures like in

Encanto."

- History: "Learning about the past helps us understand how the world has changed over time."
- Math: "Counting and numbers are like magic spells that help us solve puzzles and problems."
- Music: "Music can make you feel different emotions and bring joy to your heart."
- Physical Education: "Moving your body and staying active is important for your health and happiness."
- Science: "Exploring the world around us can lead to exciting discoveries and new knowledge."
- Social Studies: "Understanding different cultures and traditions helps us appreciate the diversity in our world."
