

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to learn about Interrupting Chicken through art and social studies activities.

Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Crayons or markers
- Books about Interrupting Chicken

No special preparation needed, just bring your creativity!

Activities

- Create Your Own Interrupting Chicken Story: Draw a picture of Interrupting Chicken and create a short story about an adventure they go on.
- Act Out a Scene: Pretend to be Interrupting Chicken and act out a scene from the book.
- Learn About Chickens: Research and draw different types of chickens. What do they eat? Where do they live?

Talking Points

- Chickens are birds that can't fly very high. They like to peck at the ground for food. You can say, "Chickens are funny birds that like to walk around and peck at the ground!"
- Interrupting Chicken is a special chicken who loves to interrupt bedtime stories. You can say, "Interrupting Chicken is so silly, always trying to join the stories!"
- When we read books, we can learn about new characters and have fun imagining their adventures. You can say, "Books take us on exciting journeys with characters like Interrupting Chicken!"
