

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to create various shapes using different materials and have fun exploring art, English, math, music, physical education, science, and social studies through Mister Maker shapes.

Materials and Prep

- Colorful construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Markers or crayons
- Mister Maker shapes inspiration

No prior knowledge needed, just bring your creativity and enthusiasm!

Activities

- Create your own Mister Maker shape collage using construction paper and glue. Cut out different shapes and arrange them on a larger paper to form a unique design.
- Practice counting by counting the number of shapes you used in your collage. Write the numbers next to each shape.
- Listen to music and move your body in the shape of the different shapes you created. Can you be a triangle? How about a circle?
- Learn about the properties of shapes by identifying how many sides and corners each shape in your collage has.
- Explore the concept of symmetry by folding your collage in half. Is it the same on both sides?

Talking Points

- Quotation: "Shapes are all around us! Can you point to a shape you see in this room?"
- Quotation: "A triangle has three sides. Let's count together - 1, 2, 3!"
- Quotation: "When we put two shapes together, we make a new shape. What shape do we get if we put a square and a triangle together?"
- Quotation: "Symmetry means that both sides look the same. Can you find something in the room that is symmetrical?"
- Quotation: "Shapes can be big or small, but they are always the same shape. Can you find something that is a circle shape?"
