

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to understand the concept of a TV show, specifically focusing on the popular show Neighbours. You will also practice vocabulary related to characters, settings, and plot development.

Talking Points

- **What is a TV Show?**
"A TV show is like a story that is divided into episodes and is acted out by actors on screen."
- **Who are the Characters in Neighbours?**
"Neighbours has characters like the Kennedys, the Rebecchis, and the Cannings. Each character has their own story and personality."
- **Why is Setting Important?**
"The setting of Neighbours, like Ramsay Street, helps create the world where the characters live and interact with each other."
- **What is Plot Development?**
"Plot development is how the story in Neighbours unfolds over time. It includes events, conflicts, and resolutions."
