

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will have improved your English skills through engaging activities inspired by the magical world of Harry Potter.

Materials and Prep

Materials needed: pen, paper, Harry Potter book or movie, internet access.

Prior knowledge required: Basic understanding of the Harry Potter series.

Activities

1. Spell Creation: Invent your own spells and write a short description of what they do.
2. Character Interview: Choose a character from the series and write a dialogue-based interview with them.
3. Story Continuation: Write a short story that continues the adventures of Harry, Hermione, and Ron after the series ends.

Talking Points

- Discuss the importance of creativity in writing and how J.K. Rowling's imagination created the world of Harry Potter. *"Just as a pencil draws on paper, let your imagination create worlds beyond reality."*
- Explore the concept of character development by analyzing how Harry, Hermione, and Ron evolved throughout the series. *"Characters are like friends - they grow, change, and learn from their experiences."*
- Encourage the student to think critically about the themes of friendship, bravery, and loyalty in the Harry Potter series. *"True friends stand by you in the darkest of times, showing courage and loyalty beyond measure."*
