

# Character Quest in Pyrrhia!

## Materials:

- Copy of 'Wings of Fire: The Dragonet Prophecy'
- Notebook or paper
- Pens or pencils
- (Optional) List of characters from the book or online resource

## Introduction: Welcome, Dragon Explorer!

Today, we're diving deep into the world of Pyrrhia, not just to follow the exciting plot of 'The Dragonet Prophecy,' but to get to know the dragons who make the story soar! Understanding characters — their personalities, why they do things, and how they interact — is key to unlocking the heart of any story. We'll focus on the five Dragonets of Destiny and maybe a few others they meet along the way.

## Activity 1: Dragonet Deep Dive

Choose **two** of the main Dragonets of Destiny (Clay, Tsunami, Glory, Starflight, Sunny). For each dragonet you choose:

1. **Describe them:** What tribe are they? What are their most noticeable physical features mentioned in the book?
2. **Personality Profile:** What are 3-5 key personality traits? (e.g., brave, loyal, grumpy, intelligent, shy, optimistic). Find at least one specific example (a quote or action) from the book that shows each trait.
3. **Motivation Mountain:** What does this dragon want most in the early parts of the book? What drives their actions?
4. **Friend or Foe?:** Describe their relationship with one *other* Dragonet of Destiny. How do they get along?

Write your answers in your notebook.

## Activity 2: Character Comparisons

Now, let's compare the two dragonets you just analyzed. You can create a Venn Diagram or a simple chart.

- What important traits do they have in common?
- What are the biggest differences in their personalities or goals?
- How do their different approaches affect the group?

Use examples from the text to support your points.

## Activity 3: Destiny's Call

Think about the Dragonet Prophecy itself. How does each of the five dragonets seem to fit (or not fit) the descriptions in the prophecy based on what you know about them so far? Does their personality align with the role they are supposedly destined for? Discuss this for at least Clay, Tsunami, and Starflight.

### **Wrap-up: Council of Characters**

Let's review! What did you discover about the dragonets today? Who is your favorite character so far, and why? How does understanding these characters make reading the story more interesting? Share your thoughts on the importance of these specific dragons to the overall adventure.

**Optional Extension:** Create a 'Character Card' for one dragonet. Include their name, tribe, picture description (no drawing needed, just describe!), key traits, a key quote, and their main goal.
