

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to understand how weather changes and identify different types of weather.

Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Crayons or colored pencils
- Internet access for weather research
- Basic understanding of the four seasons (Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter)

Activities

- Draw the Weather: Look outside your window and draw what you see. Is it sunny, cloudy, rainy, or snowy?
- Seasons Wheel: Create a wheel divided into four sections, one for each season. Draw and color the different types of weather you might see in each season.
- Weather Report: Pretend to be a weather reporter and give a report for each season. Describe the weather and how it changes.

Talking Points

- "Weather can change from day to day. Sometimes it's sunny, sometimes it's rainy."
- "Different seasons have different types of weather. For example, in winter it can be snowy, while in summer it's usually hot."
- "Understanding weather helps us know what to wear and how to plan our day."
