Objective

Materials and Prep

- One of your favorite books or a short story
- Paper and pencil

Activities

- **Character Sketch:** Choose a character from the story and draw what you think they look like. Write a short paragraph describing their personality.
- **Vocabulary Hunt:** Find 5 new words from the story. Write them down and create sentences using each word.
- **Story Sequencing:** Write down the main events of the story in order. Then, try to summarize the story in just 5 sentences.

Talking Points

- **Understanding Characters:** Characters are like people in a story. They have feelings, thoughts, and actions. What do you think the main character in our story is feeling right now?
- **Exploring New Words:** When we come across new words, it's like discovering treasures. Can you share with me one new word you found today and its meaning?
- **Summarizing the Story:** Summarizing means telling the main parts of the story in a shorter way. Can you tell me what happened at the beginning, middle, and end of our story?
