

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to understand how people, places, and environments interact and connect with each other in geography.

Materials and Prep

- World map or globe
- Pen and paper
- Colorful markers or pencils
- Internet access for research (with parental supervision)

Activities

- **Mapping Adventure:** Use the world map or globe to locate different countries. Mark them with colorful markers and create a key for each color.
- **Research Journey:** Pick a country you find interesting and research about its culture, climate, and landmarks. Draw or write down key facts.
- **Environment Explorer:** Explore your own environment – your home, backyard, or neighborhood. Note down how people interact with these places and how they are connected.

Talking Points

- "Imagine traveling to a new country. What would you want to learn about its people and places?"
- "Our environment is not just nature, but also the buildings, roads, and even the way people interact with each other."
