Objective

Materials and Prep

Materials needed: paper, pen, colored markers

Activities

- Write a Friendship Poem: Use your creativity to write a poem about friendship. Include what qualities you value in a friend.
- Role-play Scenarios: Act out different scenarios with a family member or friend where friendship is tested. Discuss how you would handle these situations.

Talking Points

- "Friendship is like a plant, it needs care and attention to grow strong."
- "Being a good listener is an important part of being a good friend. It shows that you care about the other person's feelings."
- "Trust and honesty are the foundation of any lasting friendship. Always be truthful with your friends."
