Objective

Activities

- Memory Game: Write French words on one set of cards and their English translations on another set. Play a memory game matching them.

Talking Points

• Greetings:

Say "Bonjour" (hello) and "Au revoir" (goodbye).

• Introductions:

Practice saying "Je m'appelle [Your Name]" (My name is [Your Name]).

• Common Phrases:

Learn to say "S'il vous plaît" (please) and "Merci" (thank you).
