- Why is World War II important to learn about?
 - "It helps us understand how people came together to fight for what they believed in and how we can learn from history to create a better future."
- What were some key events in World War II?
 - "Events like D-Day, the Holocaust, and the dropping of atomic bombs on Japan were important parts of World War II."
