Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to recognize and create rhyming words!

Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Colorful markers or crayons
- Your thinking cap!

Activities

- **Rhyming Match:** Write down pairs of rhyming words on separate pieces of paper. Have your child match the rhyming pairs.
- **Rhyme Time:** Sing nursery rhymes together and emphasize the rhyming words. See if your child can identify them!
- **Rhyme Draw:** Draw pictures of rhyming words and label them. For example, draw a cat and a hat!

Talking Points

- What are rhyming words?
 - "Rhyming words are words that have the same ending sounds, like cat and hat."
- Why do we use rhyming words?
 - "Rhyming words make our language fun and help us remember things better!"
- Can you give me an example of a rhyming word?
 - "Sure! Dog and log rhyme because they end with the same sound -og!"
- Let's think of more rhyming words together!
 - "How about sun and fun? They rhyme too!"
- Great job! You're a rhyming word master now!
 - "You did an amazing job today learning about rhyming words. Keep practicing and you'll become even better!"
