

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will have a basic understanding of Ostara and its significance in various subjects.

Materials and Prep

Materials: Paper, coloring supplies, music player, globe or map.

Prep: Familiarize yourself with the concept of Ostara and gather the necessary materials.

Activities

- Create an Ostara-themed drawing or painting.
- Listen to traditional music from a country that celebrates Ostara.
- Locate countries on a globe or map that observe Ostara and learn about their culture.

- In Social Studies: "Let's explore different traditions and customs related to Ostara around the world."
