Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will have a better understanding of London's culture, history, and landmarks.

Materials and Prep

- Pen and paper
- Access to the internet
- Curiosity about London

No prior knowledge needed, just an open mind and willingness to learn!

Activities

- Literary Adventure: Read an excerpt from "Oliver Twist" by Charles Dickens and discuss how London is portrayed in the book.
- Virtual Tour: Take a virtual tour of the Tower of London and make a list of interesting facts about the historical site.
- London Calling: Listen to a popular song about London (e.g., "London Calling" by The Clash) and analyze the lyrics for references to the city.

Talking Points
