

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will have a better understanding of French culture, language, and geography.

Materials and Prep

- Map of France
- French flag
- French music playlist
- French-themed snacks (croissants, cheese, etc.)
- Access to the internet for research

No prior knowledge is required for this lesson.

Activities

- Learn basic French phrases and practice pronunciation.

Use online resources to learn common French greetings and phrases. Practice speaking them out loud.

- Create a French-themed art project.

Draw or paint a picture inspired by a famous French landmark like the Eiffel Tower or the Louvre.

- Listen to French music and try to identify the lyrics.

Listen to popular French songs and try to pick out words you recognize. Look up the lyrics and see if you can understand the meaning.

- Prepare and enjoy a French snack.

Make a simple French snack like a croissant sandwich or a cheese platter. Enjoy it while learning more about French cuisine.

Talking Points

- French Language:

"Bonjour! This is a common greeting in French. Can you try saying it with the correct pronunciation?"

- French Culture:

"France is known for its rich history, art, and fashion. What are some famous French artists or designers you know?"

- Geography of France:

"France is located in Western Europe and is known for its diverse landscapes. Can you name some famous French cities?"

- French Cuisine:

"French cuisine is highly regarded worldwide. What are some popular French dishes you would like to try?"
