

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to recognize and identify flags of different countries around the world.

Materials and Prep

Materials needed: Paper, coloring supplies (crayons, markers, colored pencils), world map (optional)

Activities

1. Color Your Own Flag: Choose a country and draw/color its flag on paper. Be creative!
2. Flag Match Game: Cut out flags of different countries and match them to their respective names.
3. Flag Hunt: Look around your house for items with flags on them (books, clothes) and identify the countries.

Talking Points

- "Flags are like a special picture that represents a country. It shows things that are important to that country."
- "Each country has its own unique flag with different colors and symbols. Just like how we have our own unique things that make us special."
- "When you see a flag with stars, stripes, or other shapes, it can tell you something about the country it represents."
- "Flags are used to show pride, unity, and history of a country. People from that country feel happy when they see their flag."
- "It's fun to learn about flags because you get to explore different countries and their cultures through these colorful symbols."
