Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to create your own Pokemon-themed poems and have fun exploring your creativity!

Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Pencils or markers
- Imagination!

No prior knowledge needed, just bring your love for Pokemon!

Activities

- Create a Pokemon Haiku: Write a short poem about your favorite Pokemon using the 5-7-5 syllable format.
- Rhyme Time with Pikachu: Come up with rhyming words for Pikachu and create a fun rhyming poem.
- Pokemon Acrostic: Choose a Pokemon name and write an acrostic poem using each letter of the name to start a line.

Talking Points

• Poetry is like a special kind of writing that lets us express our feelings and ideas in a creative way.

"Poetry is like painting with words, where each word adds color to the picture we create."

• Haikus are short poems that have three lines. The first line has 5 syllables, the second has 7, and the third has 5.

"Haikus are like tiny windows that show a big view in just a few words."

• Rhyming words have similar ending sounds, like Pikachu and peek-a-boo. We can use these to make fun poems that sound nice when we read them aloud.

"Rhyming words are like a song that makes our poems dance and sing."

• An acrostic poem uses the letters of a word to start each line. It's a cool way to make a poem that's all about one thing.

"Acrostic poems are like secret codes that reveal the magic of the words we choose."
