Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to apply geometric concepts to real-life situations inspired by Jujutsu Kaisen.

Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Protractor

Activities

- 1. **Shapes in Jujutsu Kaisen:** Watch a clip from Jujutsu Kaisen and identify different shapes present in the scenes. For example, how many triangles can you find in the character designs or backgrounds?
- 2. **Design Your Curse Technique:** Create your own curse technique diagram using geometric shapes. Explain how the angles and lines represent different aspects of your technique.
- 3. **Battlefield Geometry:** Analyze fight scenes in Jujutsu Kaisen and discuss how geometry plays a role in the positioning and movements of the characters. How could understanding angles and distances give a fighter an advantage?

Talking Points
