

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to analyze and appreciate the themes and characters in classic English literature.

Materials and Prep

- Pen and notebook
- Access to classic English literature texts (e.g., Shakespeare, Jane Austen)
- Quiet study space

Prior knowledge of basic literary terms and a curiosity about exploring different perspectives are helpful for this lesson.

Activities
