

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to understand and identify various prefixes and their meanings.

Materials and Prep

- Pen and paper
- Dictionary (optional)
- No prior knowledge required

Activities

1. Create a list of 10 words with prefixes. Write down the prefix and its meaning next to each word.
2. Play a matching game. Write down a list of prefixes on one side of index cards and their meanings on the other side. Mix them up and match them correctly.
3. Challenge yourself with a prefix crossword puzzle. You can create one or find a printable puzzle online.

Talking Points

- "Prefixes are groups of letters added to the beginning of a word to change its meaning."
- "Understanding prefixes can help you figure out the meanings of unfamiliar words."
- "Common prefixes include 'un-' (meaning not), 're-' (meaning again), and 'pre-' (meaning before)."
