Talking Points

- WWE events are held in arenas all over the world, and fans gather to watch live matches and cheer for their favorite wrestlers. You can say, "WWE events are like big shows where people come to watch wrestlers compete against each other, and the audience gets really excited and loud."
- WWE wrestlers have unique personalities, costumes, and finishing moves that make them stand out from each other. You can say, "Each wrestler in WWE has their own special style, look, and moves that make them different from the others, and fans love to see their favorites in action."
