- **Complex Sentence:** One independent clause and at least one dependent clause (starts with subordinating conjunctions like 'because', 'while', 'since', 'although', 'if', 'when', etc.). (*Example: //When I logged into Adopt Me!//, I discovered my pet had grown.*)
- **Compound-Complex Sentence:** Two or more independent clauses and at least one dependent clause. (*Example: //Although Bloxburg requires Robux//, many players enjoy its detailed building system //, and// they spend hours creating virtual homes.*)

Look at these simple sentences from potential Roblox scenarios. Combine or expand them into compound, complex, or compound-complex sentences. Try to make them sound natural, like something you'd actually read or write.

Mission 2: Punctuation Power-Ups - Colons, Semicolons, and Dashes

These aren't just fancy symbols; they're tools for clarity and style!

• **Semicolon (;):** Joins two closely related independent clauses (instead of using a period or FANBOYS conjunction). Also used to separate items in a complex list.

- *Example (Joining Clauses):* The obby was challenging; I fell many times.
- *Example (Complex List):* We visited several games: Brookhaven, known for roleplay; Tower of Hell, famous for its difficulty; and Pet Simulator X, popular for collecting.
- **Colon (:):** Introduces a list, explanation, quotation, or emphasizes a point. (What follows the colon often explains or expands on what came before it).
 - *Example (List):* To build a good base, you need three things: resources, a plan, and patience.
 - *Example (Explanation):* I knew why I lost the round: my internet connection dropped.
- **Dash** (—): Used for emphasis, interruption, or to set off explanatory elements (often more informal or dramatic than parentheses or commas).
 - *Example (Emphasis):* The final item I needed—the rarest one—was finally in the shop!
 - *Example (Interruption):* If we can just get past this—watch out for that laser!—we'll win.

Mission 3: Tone & Voice - Crafting Your Digital Persona

Both convey a need, but the second uses more complex sentences, polite language, and clearer punctuation, creating a very different impression.
