Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will understand the importance of being a good citizen and how you can contribute positively to your community.

Materials and Prep

- Pen and paper
- Coloring materials
- Computer or tablet with internet access

Activities

- **Craft Time:** Create a poster showing what being a good citizen means to you. Use colors and drawings to make it fun!
- **Community Helper Research:** Look up different community helpers on YouTube (like firefighters or doctors) and learn about the important roles they play in society.
- **Good Deeds Challenge:** Perform at least one good deed for someone in your family or neighborhood. It could be helping with chores or sharing a toy.

Talking Points

- What is Citizenship?
 - "Citizenship means being a good member of your community and following rules to make it a better place for everyone."
- Why is it important to be a good citizen?
 - "Being a good citizen helps us all live together happily and peacefully. It's like being part of a big team!"
- How can you be a good citizen?
 - "You can be a good citizen by being kind to others, helping those in need, and following the rules."
- What are some examples of good deeds?
 - "Good deeds are things like sharing with others, saying thank you, and helping out without being asked."
- Why do we have rules in society?
 - "Rules help us stay safe and treat each other fairly. They make sure everyone has a chance to be happy and successful."
