Objective

By the end of this lesson, Tahlia will have a deeper understanding of camping through various subjects and activities.

Materials and Prep

- Pen and paper
- Access to the internet for research
- Outdoor space for physical activities

Prior knowledge of basic camping concepts is helpful but not required.

Activities

- Art: Create a nature-inspired sketch or painting of a camping scene.
- **English:** Write a short story about a camping adventure, focusing on descriptive language.
- **History:** Research the history of camping and create a timeline of significant events.
- Math: Plan a camping trip budget, including costs for food, equipment, and accommodations.
- **Physical Education:** Practice setting up a tent and learn basic camping exercises like hiking or yoga.
- Science: Study the flora and fauna found in camping areas and create a mini nature guide.
- **Social Studies:** Explore different camping traditions around the world and compare them to your own.

Talking Points

- Physical Education: "Setting up a tent requires physical strength and coordination. Let's practice and stay active while camping!"
- Science: "Nature is our classroom. What can we learn about the environment during our camping trip?"
- Social Studies: "Camping traditions vary globally. How do different cultures enjoy the great outdoors?"
