Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to identify letters out of order.

Materials and Prep

- Alphabet flashcards
- Whiteboard or paper
- Markers or crayons

Activities

- 1. Alphabet Scramble
 - 1. Shuffle the alphabet flashcards and place them face down on a table.
 - 2. Ask the student to pick a card and identify the letter on it.
 - 3. Encourage the student to say the letter out loud and locate it on the whiteboard or paper.
 - 4. Repeat the process with different flashcards.
- 2. Letter Hunt
 - 1. Write a random sequence of letters on the whiteboard or paper.
 - 2. Ask the student to find and circle a specific letter in the sequence.
 - 3. Repeat the process with different letters.
- 3. Letter Mix-Up
 - 1. Write a word on the whiteboard or paper, but rearrange the letters.
 - 2. Ask the student to unscramble the letters and identify the word.
 - 3. Discuss how the order of letters can change the meaning of a word.
 - 4. Repeat the process with different words.

Preschool Grade Talking Points

- "Today, we are going to have fun with letters and words!"
- "Letters can be in different orders, but they still make words."
- "We can find letters even when they are mixed up."
- "Sometimes, we can rearrange letters to make new words."
- "Let's see if we can unscramble some words and find the letters out of order!"
