

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, Elisabeth will be able to create patterns using natural materials.

## Materials and Prep

- Various natural materials such as leaves, flowers, sticks, rocks
- Outdoor space for collecting materials
- Patience and creativity

## Activities

- **Nature Scavenger Hunt:** Go on a nature walk to collect different natural materials.
