

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to analyze characters and themes in Percy Jackson and relate them to your own life.

Materials and Prep

- Copy of Percy Jackson book (any in the series)
- Pen and paper
- Quiet study space

No prior knowledge needed. Just bring your enthusiasm for Percy Jackson!

Activities

- **Percy's Personality Traits:** Read a chapter of the book and list down words that describe Percy's character. Discuss why you think he acts the way he does.
- **Design Your Own Demigod:** Create your own demigod character with a unique godly parent and special powers. Write a short story about their adventures.
- **Theme Exploration:** Identify a theme in the book (e.g., friendship, bravery) and find examples that support it. Discuss why this theme is important in the story.

Talking Points

- **Character Analysis:** "Let's think about Percy's actions in the story. How would you describe his personality?"
- **Creating Your Demigod:** "Imagine having a demigod friend like Percy. What powers would your demigod have and why?"
- **Theme Discussion:** "Why do you think the theme of friendship (or any other theme you choose) is significant in Percy Jackson's adventures?"
