Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to identify and analyze symbolism in Percy Jackson and the Olympians series.

Materials and Prep

Materials needed: Percy Jackson and the Olympians book series by Rick Riordan

Prep: Familiarize yourself with the characters and plot of the series.

Activities

1. Symbol Hunt: Pick a chapter from the book and identify any symbols present. Write a short paragraph explaining the symbolism.

2. Create a Symbolic Map: Draw a map of Camp Half-Blood and mark different locations with symbols that represent their significance in the story.

3. Design Your Own Prophecy: Write a prophecy for a new character in the series using symbolic language.
