Objective

Activities

- **Pet Care Guide:** Create a care guide for your stuffed animals or toy pets. Include feeding schedule, exercise routine, and grooming needs.
- **History of Pets:** Research and write about famous pets in history like Lassie, Rin Tin Tin, or Laika the space dog. Share your findings with your family.
- **Pet Exercise Time:** Set up an obstacle course for your toy pets and time how fast they can complete it. This will be a fun way to get moving!
- **Science of Pet Care:** Learn about the different types of pets and their habitats. Draw a picture of your ideal pet's home and explain why you chose that environment.

Talking Points

 - "One famous pet is Lassie, the brave and loyal collie who starred in movies and TV shows."
- Why is exercise important for pets?
 - "Just like us, pets need to stay active to be healthy and happy."
- How can we make sure our pets are comfortable?
 - "We can provide them with a cozy bed, toys to play with, and regular check-ups at the vet."
