## **Activities**

- **Character Analysis:** Choose a character from the book and write a short description of their personality traits and actions.
- **Illustration Time:** Pick a scene from the book and draw an illustration of it. You can get as creative as you want!
- **Research Adventure:** Look up some information about the author, C.S. Lewis, and share an interesting fact with someone in your family.

## **Talking Points**

- What is The Magician's Nephew about?
  - "The Magician's Nephew is a magical story about two children, Digory and Polly, who embark on an adventure to different worlds."
- Who are the main characters?
  - "Digory Kirke, Polly Plummer, Uncle Andrew, and Aslan the lion are some of the important characters in the book."
- What themes are explored in the book?
  - "Friendship, bravery, and the consequences of actions are some of the themes that you can discover in The Magician's Nephew."
- Why do you think C.S. Lewis wrote this book?
  - "C.S. Lewis wanted to create a fantastical world filled with adventure and moral lessons for readers to enjoy and learn from."
