Objective

Materials and Prep

Materials needed:

- Colorful construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Markers or crayons
- Popsicle sticks

Activities

• Create the Dragon Puppet:

Guide Jyemeka on how to cut out dragon shapes from paper, decorate them, and attach them to popsicle sticks to create puppets.

• Practice Puppeteering:

Encourage Jyemeka to practice moving the dragon puppet around to bring it to life.

• Record a Puppet Show:

Suggest Jyemeka to set up a mini puppet theater, create a story, and record a fun video using the dragon puppets.

Talking Points

• Dragons are mythical creatures that are often portrayed as powerful and magical beings.

"Imagine dragons flying through the sky and breathing fire like in fairy tales!"

- Puppets are like dolls that we can move with our hands to tell stories or act out scenes. "Pretend your dragon puppet is talking to you. What do you think it would say?"
- Creating your own puppet allows you to use your imagination and bring your ideas to life.
