Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to improve your English, Math, and Social Studies skills through activities related to Call of Duty.

Materials and Prep

- Computer or gaming console with Call of Duty game
- Paper and pen for note-taking
- Basic understanding of the Call of Duty game mechanics

Activities

- **English:** Write a short story inspired by a Call of Duty mission. Focus on descriptive language and creating suspense.
- Math: Calculate the average number of kills per game session in Call of Duty. Keep track of your kills for a few games and then find the average.
- **Social Studies:** Research the historical events that inspired the storyline of Call of Duty games. Write a short report on the connections between history and the game.

Talking Points

- Math Activity: "We can practice our math skills by calculating the average number of kills in the game. Let's add up the kills and divide by the number of games."
- Social Studies Activity: "Did you know that Call of Duty games are often inspired by real historical events? Let's explore the connections between the game and history."
