We will have a dance party where you can move and groove like a giraffe, swaying your long neck and legs.

## **Talking Points**

• What is a giraffe?

"Giraffes are tall animals with long necks and spots on their bodies. They are the tallest land animals in the world!"

• Why couldn't Gerald dance at first?

"Gerald thought he couldn't dance because he was different, but he learned that everyone can dance in their own way."

• What did Gerald discover about himself?

"Gerald discovered that he could dance beautifully when he found his own special rhythm."

• What is your favorite part of the story?

"Share with me which part of the book you liked the most and why!"
