Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to appreciate and create artwork inspired by Henry Hugglemonster.

Materials and Prep

- Blank sheets of paper
- Coloring pencils or crayons
- · Printouts or pictures of Henry Hugglemonster

Prior knowledge of Henry Hugglemonster and basic coloring skills would be helpful.

Activities

- 1. Introduce Henry Hugglemonster to the student by showing pictures or printouts. Explain that Henry is a friendly monster who loves to have fun.
- 2. Discuss the different colors and shapes that can be seen in Henry Hugglemonster's character design.
- 3. Encourage the student to draw their own version of Henry Hugglemonster on a blank sheet of paper using coloring pencils or crayons. They can add their own unique colors and shapes to make it their own.
- 4. After completing their artwork, have the student share their creation and explain why they chose certain colors and shapes.

Kindergarten Grade Talking Points

- "Henry Hugglemonster is a friendly monster who likes to play and have fun."
- "Look at the different colors and shapes on Henry Hugglemonster's body. Can you see any circles, triangles, or squares?"
- "Let's use our coloring pencils or crayons to draw our own Henry Hugglemonster. What colors do you want to use? What shapes will you add?"
- "Now that you've finished your artwork, tell me about the colors and shapes you chose. Why did you choose them?"
