

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to appreciate and create artwork inspired by Henry Hugglemonster.

## Materials and Prep

- Blank sheets of paper
- Coloring pencils or crayons
- Printouts or pictures of Henry Hugglemonster

Prior knowledge of Henry Hugglemonster and basic coloring skills would be helpful.

## Activities

1. Introduce Henry Hugglemonster to the student by showing pictures or printouts. Explain that Henry is a friendly monster who loves to have fun.
2. Discuss the different colors and shapes that can be seen in Henry Hugglemonster's character design.
3. Encourage the student to draw their own version of Henry Hugglemonster on a blank sheet of paper using coloring pencils or crayons. They can add their own unique colors and shapes to make it their own.
4. After completing their artwork, have the student share their creation and explain why they chose certain colors and shapes.

## Kindergarten Grade Talking Points

- "Henry Hugglemonster is a friendly monster who likes to play and have fun."
- "Look at the different colors and shapes on Henry Hugglemonster's body. Can you see any circles, triangles, or squares?"
- "Let's use our coloring pencils or crayons to draw our own Henry Hugglemonster. What colors do you want to use? What shapes will you add?"
- "Now that you've finished your artwork, tell me about the colors and shapes you chose. Why did you choose them?"
