

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will have a better understanding of Komi Can't Communicate and its cultural context through various subjects.

Materials and Prep

- Access to Komi Can't Communicate series
- Pen and paper
- Basic understanding of the Komi Can't Communicate storyline

Activities

- **Art:** Draw a comic strip based on a scene from Komi Can't Communicate.
- **English:** Write a short story inspired by the characters in Komi Can't Communicate.
- **Foreign Language:** Learn a few basic phrases in Japanese (the original language of the series).
- **History:** Research the cultural context of Japan during the time period of the series.
- **Math:** Create math problems related to the characters' interactions in the series.
- **Music:** Compose a short piece of music that reflects the mood of Komi Can't Communicate.
- **Physical Education:** Create a workout routine inspired by the characters' activities in the series.
- **Science:** Explore the science behind selective mutism, a condition Komi struggles with.
- **Social Studies:** Discuss the importance of communication in different cultures around the world.

Talking Points

- **Art:** "Art allows us to express emotions and tell stories visually."
- **English:** "Language is a powerful tool for connecting with others and sharing ideas."
- **Foreign Language:** "Learning a new language opens doors to new cultures and perspectives."
- **History:** "Understanding the past helps us make sense of the present and shape the future."
- **Math:** "Mathematics is a universal language that helps us solve problems and make sense of the world."
- **Music:** "Music has the ability to evoke emotions and create connections beyond words."
- **Physical Education:** "Physical activity is essential for a healthy body and mind."
- **Science:** "Science helps us understand the natural world and ourselves better."
- **Social Studies:** "Cultural differences enrich our understanding of humanity and promote empathy."
