Materials and Prep

Materials needed: Paper, colored pencils, magnifying glass, and a computer or tablet for research.

Activities

- **Nature Walk:** Take a nature walk in your backyard or nearby park. Observe different plants and flowers.
- **Drawing Time:** Choose your favorite plant or flower from the walk and draw it using colored pencils.
- **Research Fun:** Use the computer or tablet to research more about botanical gardens. What is your favorite plant you found?

Talking Points

- **Plants are Living Things:** "Plants are like our friends, they need water and sunlight to grow big and strong."
- **Flowers Come in Many Colors:** "Just like how we love different colors, flowers come in red, blue, yellow, and many more colors."
- **Botanical Gardens are like Plant Museums:** "Botanical gardens are special places where we can see many different plants and flowers from all around the world."
- **Plants Give Us Oxygen:** "Plants are like superheroes, they give us the air we need to breathe and stay healthy."
- **Each Plant is Unique:** "Just like how we are all different, every plant is special and unique in its own way."
- **Caring for Plants:** "Just like how we care for our pets, we need to care for plants by giving them water and sunlight."
