

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to draw flags from different countries and understand the symbolism behind them.

## Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Pencils and erasers
- Coloring materials (markers, colored pencils, crayons)
- Internet access to look up flags

No prior knowledge needed, just a curious mind and creativity!

## Activities

- **Activity 1: Flag Research**  
Use the internet to research flags from different countries. Choose a few that you find interesting.
- **Activity 2: Flag Drawing**  
Pick one of the flags you researched and try to draw it on paper. Pay attention to the colors and patterns.
- **Activity 3: Create Your Own Flag**  
Design your own flag that represents you or your family. Think about what colors and symbols are important to you.

## Talking Points

- *"Flags are like a country's special symbol. They often have colors and pictures that tell a story about the place."*
- *"Each color on a flag can have a meaning. For example, red might stand for courage, while blue could represent peace."*
- *"Some flags have stripes, stars, or other shapes. These shapes can have different meanings to the people of that country."*
